18.27 Update from Chair

- Written to the Court Leet about financial contribution towards the drain's maintenance at north end of the village and culvert to south west of the village at the bottom of the village. As yet no response but a meeting of the Court is due in October.
- All benches have now been oiled
- In response to the issue of dog bin emptying the Council have been assured that this is done regularly. In view of the pressure on the bin the possibility of another at the northern end of the village is to be considered.
- The end of the Road Speeding sign is imminent this will not be renewed
- All Grit Bins are owned by NYCC Highways with the exception of the one located near Manor Farm which is owned and maintained by the PC. Highways indicate that they will now longer replace bins that are damaged.
- The issue of the safety with the sycamore tree in the grounds of Appleton Farm will be investigated by Councillor Hall

18.28 Financial update

Additional items for next year's budget where discussed and a request made for the replacement cost of pads and battery for the village defibrillation unit.

#### 18.29 Public Rights of Way

Definitive Map Modification Order for South Ings and West Back Lane. This was raised in 2014 but due to objections was then in a situation that it would have to be referred to a Public Enquiry. County Hall had a back log of 23 cases and indicated that this modification could take four years to reach the action stage. Sadly, nothing has been done with any of the outstanding cases and no action is anticipated in the foreseeable future.

The stile in the East Back Lane was promptly repaired by The North York Moors National Park when reported by a Councillor however they stated that it would require a complete rebuild in the future.

#### 18.30 Fracking

The Fracking Advisor Group continues to circulate information concerning the current situation and the PC has responded to request for opinions by maintaining its objections to the process.
